**Volunteer Code of Conduct**

1. The most important function of a staff member or volunteer of HMI is to be a positive role model to minors. Sportsmanship, integrity, pursuit of excellence, enjoyment, loyalty & teamwork are fundamental Christian values that HMI requires and expects of all staff members and volunteers.
2. HMI expects all paid staff and volunteers, in every aspect of their involvement with HMI activities and programs, to exhibit exemplary language and conduct, consistent with HMI's ministry purpose, and moral and theological beliefs.
3. HMI prohibits staff members and volunteers from:
  - a) Engaging in any dating, romantic or sexual activity or relationship with the campers who participate in our programs;
  - b) Using sexually explicit language or jokes, or possessing or viewing lewd pornographic materials privately or in the presence of participants or others;
  - c) Engaging in sexual relations or activities that constitute sexual offenses as defined by federal or state law;
  - d) Using language or behaviour that involves violence or is derogatory, threatening, abusive or harassing;
  - e) Physically abusing others, that is, physical contact intentionally causing the participants to sustain bodily harm or personal injury, at a Christian Hockey Camp International or any other HMI event. (Given that hockey is a contact sport, it is understood that some physical risk is involved in playing the game or attending practice sessions. This risk is limited to the normal contact that is sustained when playing the game, scrimmaging, or engaging in practice sessions.)

- I understand that if my character or morals should be inappropriate (as determined by HMI) and/or criminal at any time during my volunteer service, HMI will be entitled to terminate by status as a volunteer without prior notice, regardless of any other oral or written statements made to HMI prior to, at, or following the date of volunteer service.
- I authorize HMI to use this information as it deems necessary and solely for the purpose of ensuring the safety and security of staff and participants in a Christian Hockey Camps International camp or other HMI-related event.
- I understand that HMI will not disclose this information to third parties without my consent.
