Christian Hockey Camps International: Our Statement of Faith

1. We believe in the verbal, plenary, inspiration of the Bible as originally given by God - His infallible, inerrant Word, our supreme authority in all matters of faith and conduct.
2. We believe in the one true God, the creator of heaven and earth, sovereign over all, eternally existent in three persons - Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
3. We believe in God the Son, God manifest in flesh, our Lord Jesus Christ, the world's only Saviour. We believe in His pre-incarnate existence, His virgin birth, His sinless life, His vicarious death, His burial and bodily resurrection, His ascension into heaven, His present mediatorial ministry, His imminent personal return in power and glory.
4. We believe in God the Holy Spirit, who convicts the world of sin, regenerates all believers, indwells them and enables them to live holy lives of witness to our Lord Jesus Christ.
5. We believe in the sinfulness of mankind, separated from God, subject to His eternal wrath and condemnation.
6. We believe in the eternal salvation of every one who believes in the Lord Jesus Christ, a salvation provided freely by God's grace through the shed blood, sacrificial death, and bodily resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ.
7. We believe in the bodily resurrection of all the dead: believers to the full enjoyment of eternal life; unbelievers to the full condemnation of eternal death.
8. We believe in the church, the body of Jesus Christ, composed of all who have believed in Him as Lord and Saviour.

Volunteer Code of Conduct

1. The most important function of a staff member or volunteer of HMI is to be a positive role model to minors. Sportsmanship, integrity, pursuit of excellence, enjoyment, loyalty & teamwork are fundamental Christian values that HMI requires and expects of all staff members and volunteers.
2. HMI expects all paid staff and volunteers, in every aspect of their involvement with HMI activities and programs, to exhibit exemplary language and conduct, consistent with HMI's ministry purpose, and moral and theological beliefs.
3. HMI prohibits staff members and volunteers from:
 - a. Engaging in any dating, romantic or sexual activity or relationship with the campers who participate in our programs;
 - b. Using sexually explicit language or jokes, or possessing or viewing lewd pornographic materials privately or in the presence of participants or others;
 - c. Engaging in sexual relations or activities that constitute sexual offenses as defined by federal or state law;
 - d. Using language or behaviour that involves violence or is derogatory, threatening, abusive or harassing;
 - e. Physically abusing others, that is, physical contact intentionally causing the participants to sustain bodily harm or personal injury, at a Christian Hockey Camp International or any other HMI event. (Given that hockey is a contact sport, it is understood that some physical risk is involved in playing the game or attending practice sessions. This risk is limited to the normal contact that is sustained when playing the game, scrimmaging, or engaging in practice sessions.)

I will abide by the HMI Volunteer Code of Conduct.

Release

- I declare that I have read and understood the above form and have completed it accurately and that no false or misleading information has been given.

- I grant permission to HMI to follow up on any information provided. I consent to a background check/criminal records check and, upon request, am willing to provide such from my local police force. I understand that the results will be kept confidential.

- I grant permission to HMI to contact any previous employer or volunteer organization where I have worked, regardless of whether or not I have listed them as a reference.

- I understand that HMI is responsible for the welfare of any person or persons entrusted to my care. I will cooperate fully with the staff in the fulfillment of my duties and will keep in confidence whatever information is shared with me by a camper, staff or other volunteer. I understand that I am obliged to report cases of abuse when I am made aware of them.

- I understand that if my character or morals should be inappropriate (as determined by HMI) and/or criminal at any time during my volunteer service, HMI will be entitled to terminate by status as a volunteer without prior notice, regardless of any other oral or written statements made to HMI prior to, at, or following the date of volunteer service.

- I authorize HMI to use this information as it deems necessary and solely for the purpose of ensuring the safety and security of staff and participants in a Christian Hockey Camps International camp or other HMI-related event.

- I understand that HMI will not disclose this information to third parties without my consent.
