# Your Unique Gifts

A few years ago, I traveled to the Gulf Coast with a group from my church on a post-Katrina mission trip. There were two other churches there, about 130 people altogether. The leaders put us into groups of about six to eight workers and sent us to the various work-sites. Our team was sent to a house that had already been gutted and mostly put back together by groups that went before us, and so by then it just needed some drywall finishing and a lot of painting. That was good, since most of us weren't very experienced in the handyman department.

As we got to work, one of our team members, with an eye for details, began to notice something we all had in common. Every one of our six-person crew was left-handed! While it's true that paintbrushes and sanding blocks are bi-lateral tools, it was good that we weren't all somewhere that we'd need to stand on our heads to use a circular saw, for instance.

I still don't know if it was an amazing co-incidence, or if the organizers factored in hand-writing analysis of our applications as they determined who would be assigned where. I do know that as the week went on, one thing after another would happen, one conversation after another, all confirming that each one of us was EXACTLY where we were supposed to be that week. When the homeowner came by on Friday as we were packing up to leave, SHE immediately started praying for US. We knew that we were the ones who were blessed by the opportunity.

I was inspired to re-read the Old Testament story of Ehud in Judges 3. Like many of the colorful characters in Judges, Ehud utilized his uniquely configured collection of gifts (most noticeably, his left-handedness), in leading the nation of Israel in their struggles with their enemies.

Many passages in the New Testament talk about Fruit of the Spirit as well as Spiritual Gifts. The NLT version of Ephesians 4:7 says, "He has given each one of us a special gift according to the generosity of Christ." Other versions identify that special gift as God's grace. I know you've heard it said that we are blessed to be a blessing. How have you been blessed? How does your unique collection of gifts and talents play out in your life? How are they being put to use? Your world, your church, and your Emmaus Community all have unique needs, and YOU hold the key to putting your unique collection of gifts to work in filling those needs.

Our website, www.trwe.org has several tools that can help you with this:

- On-line sign-ups for 4<sup>th</sup> Day service to support the upcoming Walks
- On-line sign-ups for the Prayer Vigil
- On-line "Desire to Serve" forms that allow you to pro-actively communicate ways that you feel led to serve
- On-line Spiritual Gifts Assessment. Check it out. You might be surprised to learn of ways that God has blessed you.
- On-line registration forms. Yes, we need folks to exercise their gift of Sponsorship. **Pray** for God to reveal to you that individual or couple whom YOU are uniquely positioned to sponsor. Then go and talk with them!
- If you're not "on-line" or technically-savvy, you can call one of your Emmaus friends who are and give them the chance to use their techno-gifts to help you along.


Money should never keep a pilgrim or team member from participating in a Walk. Do what you can today to make sure the Emmaus community is able to continue providing financial assistance to those who need it.

Make a right turn at 84 Lumber on the right onto Dick Road. In approximately 1 1./2 miles, turn right and that will take you to the camp.

If traveling from the North, take I 79 to Route 422, make a left on to Route 422 and follow above directions.

you are traveling from the East, take Route 8 to Route 422, and head west 7 miles to 84 Lumber. Make a left hand turn on to Dick Road. The main entrance is 1.5 miles down the road.
